

School Age Summer Behavior Contract

Our school age teachers spend a lot of time planning educational and fun activities for the children during the summer months. In order to have a safe and mutually respectful environment for all children that attend Camelot, we want to have clear rules and expectations.

This summer we will be doing a Clip Up and Clip Down Chart for behavior. Each child will start in the middle of the chart at the beginning of the day and have the opportunity to clip up three times for good behavior or clip down three times for poor behavior, the lowest clip down being "Parent Contact". If your child clips down to "Parent Contact" 3 times, there will be a discussion between the child, their teachers and parents. Pending circumstances of the behavior and the time frame they occur in, **the child may be unable to go on the next field trip and not attend Camelot the day of the planned trip.**

As a whole class incentive to make good choices, each classroom will have a paper bucket hung on the wall that as a class they will try to fill together. Haley's class will have their own bucket and Andrea and Katie's class will have their own. When the class collectively is making good choices a shape will be added to the bucket, however, if the class is making poor choices a shape will be taken away. If the bucket gets filled, together the class will choose what they want as their reward.

Finally, we want to remind the kids that they are responsible for their actions and choices. Poor choices that may result in a clip down include hurting others by kicking, hitting, pushing, etc, and using inappropriate language. Swearing and using inappropriate words will not be tolerated at Camelot. We encourage the kids to use kind words and try to work out problems amongst themselves before getting the teachers involved; however, when needed the school age teachers will step in. We also encourage the kids to think about how they are treating their friends and to make positive choices. We feel we have a great group of children and we hope everyone will be able to participate in all the events of the summer. Please encourage your child(ren) to make good choices and follow expectations.
