

Welcome to Carol, Danielle and Madisanne's Classroom!

*Welcome to our room as your child continues to grow and move on throughout the center. Here are some of the fun & exciting things we will be up to....

*Please check out our **Bulletin Board** located outside the room. Carol and Danielle's room is on the **left** and Madisanne's is on the **right**. Each room posts the weekly themed-lesson plan. Each room will also post an emergent curriculum each day, which tells you about your child's daily activities. It includes art/sensory, books and songs, the menu, and the fun activities we did that day.

*If your child eats breakfast at Camelot, we ask that you are here BY 7:30 am. Morning snack is served around 9/9:15 am, lunch at 11 am, and afternoon snack is around 2:30 pm. At mealtimes, we will continue to encourage your child to try everything and use their spoon. They will have a labeled sippy cup to use each day. As they start to approach TWO years old, they will start using an open cup. We will also practice **saying** "More" & "Please" to go with the sign language. We also say a little prayer before eating at each meal time, which is picked by the leader.

*Your child will be on the monthly snack calendar. Please bring a healthy snack to share for 16 children (See attached: Nutritious Snack Ideas). Please be sure to check serving sizes and the ingredient labels. **Sugar cannot be the first ingredient!**

*Your child will sleep on their own sleeping bag in which you will provide. Please include a pillowcase to store the sleeping bag in our room on the shelf. All sleeping bags will be sent home on Fridays to be washed and returned on Monday.

* We will be practicing self-help skills as your child continues to grow. We encourage the children to take off and put on their own shoes. The children will also practice putting on their own coats and accessories (as needed).
