Welcome to the 4/5 yr. old classroom! We are so excited to have you with us. We will continue focusing on learning the essentials for Kindergarten while having fun! We will focus on all the domains of learning through: literacy, math and science, sensory, dramatic play, small groups and circle time.

Our classroom runs a little different than the others during the school year. In the mornings, your child will be with Miss Alexis and at 8:20 am Ms. Jamie – the school district's 4K teacher - will come into our room. If your child does not have 4K that day; they will go with Miss Alexis into the Rumpus Room. 4K runs until 11:00 am; Ms. Jean will then join Miss Alexis for the rest of the afternoon in the regular classroom.

We continue with "Leader Days", when it is your child's leader day we ask that you please bring in a nutritious snack for 20 children. When it is your child's birthday, you may bring in a special treat as long as you bring something healthy to go with it. They may also bring in a book for us to read during our afternoon circle time. We ask at this time that food is store bought and to bring nothing homemade. If you are bringing fruit; please leave it uncut.

In our classroom we have a "Family Tree", we ask you to please bring in a picture of your child's family to put up on our tree. This picture will be put on the tree to display all of our different families included in our room.
